City of Rockport Rescinds Boil Water Notice

On Thursday, March 10, 2016, the City of Rockport (PWS ID 0040002), as a precautionary measure, issued a Boil Water Notice as required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to inform our customers that due to a storm related low pressure situation, water from our system had to be boiled prior to consumption.

Pressure was restored immediately, disinfectant levels were tested throughout the system during the day on March 10 and remained in compliance the entire time. Bacteriological samples were also collected and submitted to the laboratory. Lab results received this morning indicate no bacteriological concerns, the water remains safe to drink and no longer needs to be boiled.
