Notice is hereby given that the Rockport City Council will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, April 25, 2017, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting will be held at Rockport City Hall, 622 E. Market, Rockport, Texas. The matters to be discussed and acted upon are as follows:

Opening Agenda

Please limit comments to three (3) minutes. In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Council may not discuss or take action on any item that has not been posted on the agenda.

Consent Agenda

All consent agenda items listed are considered to be routine by the City Council and will be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a Council Member so requests, in which event the item will be removed from the Consent Agenda and considered in its normal sequence on the agenda.

Deliberate and act on second and final reading of an Ordinance amending Chapter 66 of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions," by the addition of a new Article IV "Sex Offender Resident Restriction," making it unlawful for certain sex offenders to reside within 1,000 feet of premises where children gather or another sex offender resides, or to loiter within 300 feet of a park safety zone, providing penalties and injunction for violations of the Ordinance, including but not limited to a fine not to exceed \$500.00 for each offense, and each and every day such violation shall continue or exist shall be deemed a separate offense; providing for the validity of said Ordinance; repealing all prior ordinances in conflict herewith; and providing for an effective date.
13. Deliberate and act to select areas for annexation and authorize staff to prepare service plans, schedule public hearings, and draft annexation ordinance.
14. Reports from Council.
