ORDER FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE

This matter was presented to the court to ascertain the economic circumstances of the Defendant and determine the appropriate manner by which fine and costs assessed in the above styled and numbered cause(s) can be discharged.

After careful consideration of this matter, the Court find as follows:

1. That the Defendant is indigent and has made a reasonable bona fide attempt to make the required payment of the fines(s) and costs.
2. That it is the State's pedagogical interest that the Defendant discharge his fine(s) and costs by performing community service work as an alternative sentence pursuant to this Court's order below.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED that the Defendant perform _____ hours of volunteer community service work for a governmental entity or a non-profit organization that provided services to the general public that enhances social welfare and the general well-being of the community. The Defendant must work a minimum of 8 (eight) hours each week and shall discharge \$50.00 of fine(s) and costs for each 8 (eight) hours of community service performed.

The Defendant shall have all Community Service hours completed by the _____ day of _____, 20____, and show proof of completion to the court or show cause why he/she has failed to follow this Court's order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant's failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this order may result in arrest and confinement to jail until the fine(s) and costs assessed against him in this cause have been fully discharged as provided by law.
