BACKGROUND: The City Council adopted Resolution No. 2022-04 on February 8, 2022, ordering a General Election to be conducted on May 7, for the purpose of electing a Mayor at-large, a Council Member to represent Ward #2 and a Council Member to represent Ward #4. On March 8, 2022, the Council accepted a Certification of Unopposed Candidates by the City Secretary for Council Member Ward #2 and Council Member Ward #4. Council adopted a Resolution declaring the unopposed candidates for Ward #2 and Ward #4 elected to office, cancelling the Ward 2 and Ward 4 elections for May 7, 2022.

The City contracted with Aransas County Elections Administrator to conduct the May 7, 2022, General Election.

The General Election for Mayor, at-large, was conducted on Saturday, May 7, 2022, in accordance with State Election Codes. The accompanying Resolution will be the official document Canvassing the results of the May 7, 2022, General Election. The final official numbers of votes cast will be received and provided to Council before the meeting and those numbers will be entered onto the Resolution.

A RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2022, GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE ELECTED OFFICE OF MAYOR, AT-LARGE; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO THE 2022 CITY OF ROCKPORT GENERAL ELECTION; AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKPORT, TEXAS:

WHEREAS, in accordance with the general laws and Constitution of the State of Texas, and the City's Home Rule Charter at the Tuesday, February 8, 2022, Regular Meeting the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2022-04, a Resolution ordering a General Election and establishing procedures for said election to be held on Saturday, May 7, 2022. The General Election was called for the purpose of electing a Mayor, at large, a Council Member to represent Ward #2, and a Council Member to represent Ward #4; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Subchapter C, Chapter 2, Election Code, at the March 8, 2022, City Council Meeting the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2022-11, a Resolution declaring unopposed candidates in the May 7, 2022, General Election, elected to office; cancelling the Saturday, May 7, 2022, Ward 2 and Ward 4 Elections; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rockport contracted with the Elections Administrator of Aransas County to conduct a General Election on Saturday, May 7, 2022, for City of Rockport Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Aransas County Elections Administrator conducted a General Election on Saturday, May 7, 2022, for City of Rockport Mayor, at-large; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau reports the total estimated population for the City of Rockport is 10,604. The Elections Administrator of Aransas County advised that the City's current voter registration list for Mayor, at-large, contained _____ total registered voters.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKPORT, ARANSAS COUNTY, TEXAS:
