
CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING AGENDA TOUR OF CITY FACILITIES

Notice is hereby given that the Rockport City Council will hold a special meeting on Monday, June 14, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. **The meeting will be mobile** and begin and end at the Training Room of the Rockport Service Center, 2751 State Highway 35 Bypass, Rockport, Texas, with social distancing guidelines and using the video conferencing application ZOOM. A temporary suspension of the Open Meetings Act to allow telephone or video conference public meetings has been granted by Governor Greg Abbott. These actions are being taken to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding meetings that bring people into a group setting and in accordance with Section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code. **Video conferencing capabilities will be utilized to allow individuals to address the City Council. 1. Call meeting to order at the Rockport Service Center – Training Room, 2751 State Highway 35 Bypass.
2. Approximately 9:00 a.m. Depart Rockport Service Center (2751 State Highway 35 Bypass, Rockport, Texas) for a driving tour of Parks and ongoing Economic Development Projects.
3. Approximately 10:15 Tour of Wastewater Treatment Plant (1401 FM 2165, Rockport, TX). The City Council will recess its open meeting and reconvene in Closed Session Pursuant to Texas Government Code Section § 551.089 (3) Deliberation Regarding Security Devices to deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices related to Wastewater Treatment Plant.
4. The City Council will reconvene into Regular Session upon conclusion of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Closed Session and may recall any item posted for Closed Session for action, as necessary.

7. Approximately 1:30 p.m. Tour of Departments located at the Laurel Street Facilities (402 E. Laurel Street, Rockport, Texas). Please note due to social distancing requirements the number of persons allowed to enter the building will be limited.
8. Approximately 3:15 p.m. Tour of the Public Safety Center (714 E. Concho Street, Rockport, Texas). The City Council will recess its open meeting and reconvene in Closed Session Pursuant to Texas Government Code Section § 551.089 (3) Deliberation Regarding Security Devices to deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices related to Public Safety Center (PD).
9. The City Council will reconvene into Regular Session upon conclusion of the Public Safety Center Closed Session and may recall any item posted for Closed Session for action, as necessary.
10. Approximately 4:30 p.m. return to the Rockport Service Center (2751 State Highway 35 Bypass, Rockport, Texas).

11. Citizens to be heard.

At this time, comments limited to three (3) minutes will be taken from the audience from persons who have signed the speaker's card located on the table in the back of the Training Room of the Service Center and delivered to the City Secretary before the meeting begins, or written comments received by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting, on any subject matter that is not on the agenda, will be read by the Mayor and summarized in the minutes of the meeting. Persons wishing to address the Council and who have registered using the Citizen Participation Form will have up to three minutes to speak. In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Council may not discuss or take action on any item that has not been posted on the agenda. While civil public criticism is not prohibited; disorderly conduct or disturbance of the peace as prohibited by law shall be cause for the chair to terminate the offender's time to speak.
