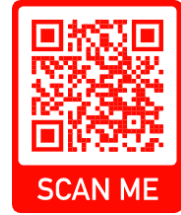
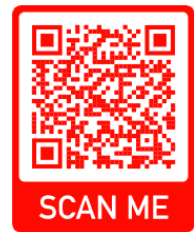

CORRECTED CITY COUNCIL AGENDA

Notice is hereby given that the Rockport City Council will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, November 24, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting will be held using the video conferencing application ZOOM. **No in-person meeting will be conducted at the Rockport Service Center.** A temporary suspension of the Open Meetings Act to allow telephone or video conference public meetings has been granted by Governor Greg Abbott. These actions are being taken to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding meetings that bring people into a group setting and in accordance with Section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code. **Video conferencing capabilities will be utilized to allow individuals to address the City Council. Members of the public can participate in the meeting remotely via Zoom at <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/82441105587> or scan the QR code to the right.**



Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the attorney general has said: “statutes that may be interpreted to require face-to-face interaction between members of the public and public officials are suspended; provided, however, that the governmental bodies must offer alternative methods of communicating with their public officials.” Public participation is valued and citizens wishing to express their views on any topic or agenda item can either electronically submit a citizen participation form in order to register to speak by going to <https://rockport.seamlessdocs.com/f/CouncilCitizenParticipation> or scanning the QR code to the right. Using the same form, citizens can also provide written comments to the City Secretary by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting. The Mayor will read the comments and they will be summarized in the minutes of the meeting.



The matters to be discussed and acted upon are as follows:

At this time, written comments received by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting, on any subject matter that is not on the agenda, will be read by the Mayor and summarized in the minutes of the meeting. Persons wishing to address the Council and who have registered using the Citizen Participation Form will have up to three minutes to speak. In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Council may not discuss or take action on any item that has not been posted on the agenda. While civil public criticism is not prohibited; disorderly conduct or disturbance of the peace as prohibited by law shall be cause for the chair to terminate the offender’s time to speak.

Consent Agenda

All consent agenda items listed are considered to be routine by the City Council and will be enacted by one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a Council Member so requests, in which event the item will be removed from the Consent Agenda and considered in its normal sequence on the agenda.

Deliberate and act on first reading of an Ordinance amending the Official Zoning Map as stipulated under Article 4.1 of the City of Rockport Zoning Ordinance Number 1027 by changing the zoning of land from R-1 (1st Single Family Dwelling District) to B-1 (General Business District) for property located at 1125 West Market Street; also known as Lot 8-R, Block 4, West Terrace Subdivision Unit 1, City of Rockport, Aransas County, Texas; to add additional storage space to an existing business; repealing all ordinances in conflict therewith; providing for severability; and providing an effective date.
15. Deliberate and act on a Resolution adopting the Texas Coalition for Affordable Power's Professional Services Agreement and GEXA Energy's Commercial Electric Service Agreement for power to be provided on and after January 1, 2023.
16. Deliberate and act on first reading of an Ordinance extending a Moratorium for six months on the acceptance of applications for the issuance of permits for the use of a location as an internet sweepstakes café of similar gaming matching establishments in the City of Rockport; directing

City staff to study and make a recommendation to City Council regarding appropriate regulations for internet sweepstakes cafes or similar gaming machine establishments; providing for a methods of repeal of this Moratorium, providing for severability; providing for a repealer clause and an effective date.

22. *Postponed – November 10, 2020:* Deliberate and act on the first reading of a proposed Ordinance authorizing the closing, vacating and abandonment of 0.689 acre of land being a 100-foot wide portion of Third Street lying between Blocks 100 and 101, Manning Addition, City of Rockport, Aransas County, Texas, according to the Plat Recorded in Volume 1, Page 7, Plat Records of Aransas County, Texas; providing for the terms and conditions of such vacation and abandonment; authorizing the Mayor to execute a Quitclaim Deed for the 0.689 acre to be closed, vacated and abandoned; and providing for an effective date.
