PLANS UNDERWAY FOR 14TH ANNUAL TROPICAL CHRISTMAS EVENTS

ROCKPORT, TX – Entertainment is being finalized, vendors contacted, and entry forms accepted for many of the special events that will take place during the 14th Annual Tropical Christmas festival on Saturday, December 1.

Tropical Christmas is a day-long extravaganza kicking off the holiday season with fun, festivities, fireworks and more in Historic Rockport.
