ENJOY A COOL FOURTH OF JULY

ROCKPORT, TX – Want to enjoy the annual Fourth of July fireworks without sweltering from the heat? Then come to the Community Aquatic Center for a first-of-its kind event.

The pool will be open normal hours from 9 am – 5 pm. It will re-open at 6 pm and remain open until 11 pm. Visitors can enjoy swimming, live music by Three's a Crowd, food, and viewing of the fireworks at sunset. In addition to its regular offerings, the concessions stand will also be selling hot dogs in honor of this special holiday.

Admission is \$4 per person for individuals over the age of one. The Aquatic Center will not be offering free readmission to those who visited earlier in the day.

Nestled within a 12-acre live oak forest, the Community Aquatic and Skate Park is open year-round. The park houses an 8-lane, heated, 25-yard pool and diving area, a whale shaped zero-depth entry children's pool with slides and sprays, a bathhouse, and a 6,000 square foot modular skate park. Adjacent to the aquatic and skate park is a picnic area, playground, a 1/4 mile nature trail, and access to the Tule Hike and Bike Trail.
