LIFEGUARD TRAINING PROGRAM ANNOUNCED

ROCKPORT, TX – The Community Aquatic & Skate Park, in conjunction with the American Red Cross, will host a lifeguard training program in September at its facility, located at 2001 Stadium Drive. Interested individuals should be at least 15 years old, able to complete a 300-yard swim doing the front crawl and breast strokes, and tread water for a minimum of two minutes using legs only.

Prior to enrolling in the class, individuals must complete a skills test of the criteria listed above, as well as a timed 20-yard swim and the retrieval of a weight from a 7-10 foot depth. The skills tests will be held September 17-20 and reservations must be made in advance.

Upon successful completion of the skills test, the individual may enroll in the class, which takes place from 9 am – 4 pm on September 21-22 and September 28-29. Cost for the program is \$175.

Individuals who may wish to seek employment with the City as a lifeguard, should also fill out a job application form, which are available at the Rockport Service Center, located at 2751 SH 35 Bypass, or online in the “Jobs” section on the City’s web site – www.cityofrockport.com. The City will be providing three certification scholarships for lifeguard positions.
